The Nijagal Family Scholarship Foundation 2021 Scholarship Requirements

The Nijagal Family Scholarship Foundation is to assist seniors graduating from Tracy High School in meeting part of their expenses pursuing educational opportunities. This scholarship is awarded to meritorious seniors (a selective few) graduating in 2021. The scholarship amount is **up to a maximum of \$750 each and up to a maximum of four scholarships** awarded based on each applicant's qualification.

These students must have plan attending a four year undergraduate degree program at a University of California (UC) or a California State University (CSU) or attending a two year community college in the fall of 2021. Undergraduate Degree Programs are eligible for scholarship including Medical Science, Engineering, Computer Science, Law or Performing Arts. Students pursuing the Associated Degree Programs are also eligible for scholarship.

Qualifications to apply for the scholarship:

- Students who have taken advanced courses in all four years of high school
- ✤ GPA in all four years of high school must have 3.5 to 4.0 (graduating with distinction)
- ✤ SAT or ACT Scores
- Excellent attendance, Saturday School (less than 15 hours), or any disciplinary action from the Tracy High School Administration or staff. Outstanding moral character.
- Two letters of recommendation from your teacher in the field of study related to the undergraduate or associate degree program.
- Submit an essay of 160 words or less, explaining your goals and how you value education in your career plan. What are your plans in motivating others to take up education beyond high school?
 - Engineering and Computer Science: letters of recommendation from science and mathematics teacher.
 - Law: letters of recommendation from English and Speech/Debate teachers
 - Performing arts: appropriate faculty members recommendation letter
- Letter(s) of recommendation from the community organization recognizing your volunteer work during junior and senior years in Tracy High School.
- Financial hardship in pursuing four year or two year college education
- Copy of an official transcript
