

Tracy Breakfast Lions Dennis Noble Scholarship Award

For the 2019-2020 Academic Year

The Tracy Breakfast Lions Club is part of the international organization of Lions clubs. The motto of the Lions Club is, "We Serve." The Tracy Breakfast Lions have been serving Tracy since 1960. As part of our youth outreach program we award scholarships each year to graduating seniors from Tracy high schools. This year we will award as many as seven \$1000.00 scholarships.

To be eligible for a scholarship, the applicant must:

1. Be a graduating senior from any Tracy high school in the year application is made.
2. Intend to enroll in an accredited two or four-year college or university.

The awards will be based on community service, leadership and academic achievement. Funds will be dispersed upon evidence of attendance at the college or university. In the event that the winner does not attend a college or university beginning in the fall semester immediately following completion of high school, the scholarship will be forfeited. An application is attached. In addition to the application, candidates should submit the following two items:

1. LETTERS OF REFERENCE

Two letters of reference are required. One of the letters must be from a teacher in whose class you have either completed or are currently enrolled and will complete by graduation. The second letter can be from a person of your choice.

2. STUDENT'S PERSONAL STATEMENT

We ask you to write a 500-word essay, typed, on the topic, "WHAT COMMUNITY SERVICE MEANS TO ME." The thoughts and structure of the essay must be your own. Possible comments may include your definition of community service, the value of community service in the Tracy area, your personal experiences in community service, or what you have learned from your experiences.

A copy of your transcript with your application would be appreciated, but not required. Applications not having a copy of the transcript will be evaluated.
