WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

A student may qualify for the Academic Block T in one of two ways.

- A. Straight A's (or a Semester **TGPA** of 4.0 or higher)
 - 1. Freshmen with Straight A's in their first semester (FALL of 2020) at Tracy High are eligible for the Academic Block T.
 - 2. Sophomores, juniors, and seniors with Straight A's (or a Semester TGPA of 4.0 or higher) in either of their two most recent semesters (FALL or SPRING 2020) at Tracy High are eligible for the Academic Block T.

In order for students to earn their Academic Block T using the Straight A's (or a Semester TGPA of 4.0 or higher) option, they must have taken a minimum of three courses from the University of California A-G list during their Straight A's (or a TGPA of 4.0 or higher) semester. The A-G list is available on the THS website in the course catalog under counseling.

- **B.** Cumulative Academic Grade Point Average (9-12) (called ACA GPA (9-12) on transcript)
 - 1. At the end of the first semester of the school year (FALL 2020), sophomores with a Cumulative Academic GPA (9-12) of 3.94 or higher on their transcript, juniors with a Cumulative Academic GPA (9-12) of 3.85 or higher, and seniors with a Cumulative Academic GPA (9-12) of 3.75 or higher on their transcript are eligible for the Academic Block T.

In order for students to earn their Academic Block T using the Cumulative Academic GPA (9-12) option, they must have taken <u>a minimum of three courses</u> from the University of California A-G list <u>in each semester</u> of high school they have completed. The A-G list is available on the THS website in the course catalog under counseling.

*A photo of your transcript can be submitted as long as it is clear and contains your name, your classes, and your GPA information.
